Yellow-rumped Warbler; NMOV; Taos, NM; Taos County; Individuals=19

These warblers were observed by me, Tom Jackman, Ann Ellen Toumey (AM only) and John Lay.

They were observed in 5 different areas:

Rio Fernando: 2 Ind + 4 Ind

Rio Pueblo: 5 Ind + 5 Ind + 3 Ind

All sightings were in riparian areas.

Many of the individuals were giving their contact call, though all counted birds were actually visually observed.

All were drab, often showing both yellow rumps and yellow wing patches.

We did not note any distinguishing between possible Audubon, Myrtle sub-species.

Nearby winter records:

NMOV: This is the 4th year that YRWA has been recorded on this count.

NMDI (Count center 16 miles SW of NMOV center): YRWA recorded 10 out of 18 years.
